Includes short presentation on Coastal Painted Turtles at Minnehada

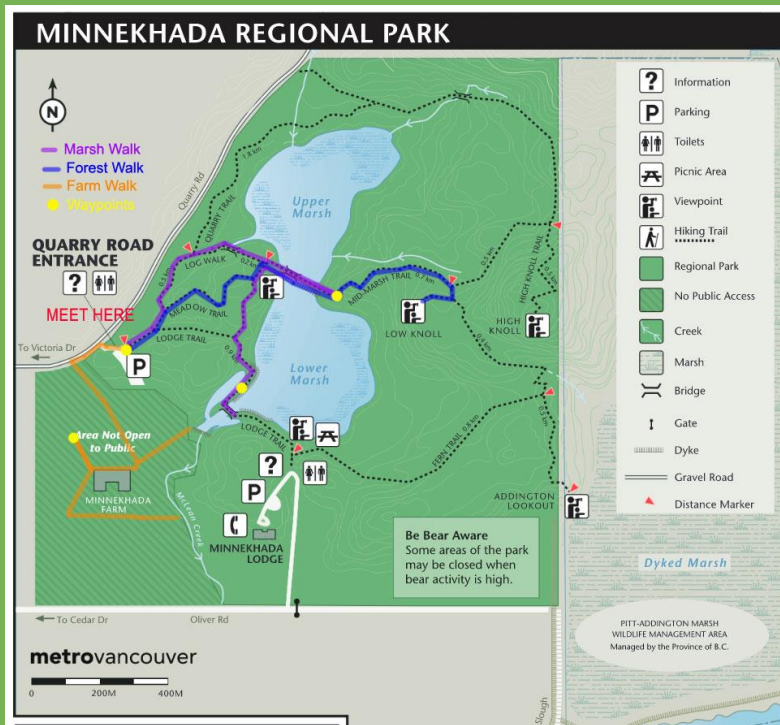
Forest Walk 9:15 AM
